### Vice Presidential Debate Preparation/ Notes

#### ✚ Summary

- I am the vice presidential candidate for the Veritas et Iustitia Party. Our party stands for truth, justice, and freedom. We support a laissez-faire economy and respect for the individual right.
- The Veritas et Iustitia Party holds a variety of views on many policies ranging from gun control to minimum wage to biological research.
- We oppose gun control as taking away guns from the general population will not stop criminals from obtaining weapons; it will only leave law-abiding citizens defenseless. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment says that the right to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed.
- We oppose raising the minimum wage. If the minimum wage were raised, it might benefit certain communities; however, the consequences within the economy would soon cancel it out. Inflation would rise. Local and small businesses would be destroyed, which would in turn create a lack of jobs and affect large businesses and chains.
- We support the expansion of the medical field through stem cell research but believe it should be restricted to methods other than embryonic research.
- Though some would disagree, police funding should be increased to better control crime and protect the people. The police are committed to upholding the law and defending those who cannot, but they currently do not have enough people or funding to properly do their job.
- The Covid-19 response in many ways was unconstitutional and medically unnecessary. Though this party acknowledges the tragic deaths caused by this virus, mask wearing should be optional and vaccines must not be mandated. These things should remain a choice and not be forced.
- Human trafficking, the practice of illegally transporting people from one country to another, typically for forced labor or sexual exploitation, is a serious and terrible issue that must be decreased. To do this a department should be added to the police force to stop and eliminate human trafficking and find missing persons.
- In 2020 and 2021, President Biden withdrew the U.S. troops from Afghanistan. Though irreparable damage has already been done by withdrawing the troops, the United States government should establish an active intelligence network in Afghanistan to continue

anti-terrorism efforts and create a humanitarian aid system for the Afghan people through independent organizations.

- Throughout history, Israel and the Middle East have been at war. Many refuse to acknowledge it as separate from Palestine and its capital as Jerusalem. The United States should support and protect the nation of Israel. It should hold true to the Judeo-Christian values it was founded upon, as well as defend the only real democracy in the Middle East, one surrounded by neighboring countries who wish to destroy it.
